COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOL

As we welcome guests back to our events, we want you to know that we are committed to providing a safe, clean, positive environment in which to play and spectate. Please remember that these new policies and procedures are in the interest of protecting public health and preventing the spread of COVID-19. We are working to first keep you safe, and second provide a great player and guest experience. We appreciate your patience and understanding with these new policies and procedures necessary in this unprecedented time. During your visit, if at any time you have a question or concern, please find the nearest staff or volunteer member and we will assist you.

Lebanon Baptist Church, along with all of the third-party, outside organizations and individuals, must follow these guidelines at all events on the campus of Lebanon Baptist Church:

ATHLETES, COACHES, GAME OFFICIALS PROTOCOL

Questionnaire/Waiver Documents

- Pre-screening COVID-19 questionnaire & proper forms must be completed prior to entering the facility by all third-party organizations/personal rentals.

Temperature Checks

- Coaches, players, and game personnel are required to have their temperature taken at the facility each day prior to entering. Temperature will be taken with a noncontact infrared forehead thermometer. Any participant with a temperature over 99.9 degrees will be asked to leave.

Mask policy within the facility

- Coaches will be REQUIRED to wear a mask while coaching during there a game.
- Players will be REQUIRED to wear a mask (Bench Area) unless they are playing in a game
- Game officials will be REQUIRED to wear a mask during all officiating a game.
- Spectators and individuals will be REQUIRED to wear a mask at all times.

Basketballs and/or other Equipment

- Only Coaches will be allowed to bring Basketballs and Equipment into the facility.
- Basketballs will be disinfected prior to play.

Backpacks

- Only one backpack per person is permitted inside the building.

Beverages/Concessions:

- Teams/athletes are recommended to bring their own water bottles and drinks.
- Teams are responsible for disposing of their water bottles following the game.
- Water fountains at the facility will be disabled. There will be no team or shared coolers. Water and sport beverages along with individually wrapped food items will be available for purchase onsite for Upward basketball.

SPECTATOR/RENTER & FACILITY PROTOCOL

Temperature Checks

- Spectators are required to have their temperature taken each day at the facility prior to entering.
- Temperature will be taken with a non-contact infrared forehead thermometer.
- Any spectator with a temperature over 99.9 degrees will be asked to leave.

Mask policy within the facility

- Spectators will be REQUIRED to wear a mask and must bring their own mask. If they do not bring their own mask, spectators can purchase a mask upon check-in.

Occupancy

- Limited number of spectators during each game session (2) Per Roster Player or their immediate family unit.
- Teams and spectators will be required to leave the gym IMMEDIATELY + following their game.

Social Distancing

- Ensure minimum of six feet between spectators when entering and when inside the facility, unless they are family members.
- Team benches and spectator seating will be adjusted to adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Signage will be posted throughout the facility to ensure proper social distancing.
- Entrances and exits will be clearly marked. Everyone will enter the facility through one door and exit through another door.

Admission and Payment Methods

- To further protect our guests and team members, we have implemented a cashless payment system using cash app.
- Cash option will still be available.

Cleaning procedures

- Sanitation stations will be located throughout the facility.
- Sanitation staff are using the CDC, state, and local recommendations for cleaning.
- Staff has increased the frequency of cleaning benches, seating, restrooms, consumption spaces, and frequently touched countertops/doors with sanitizing solution.

GAME PROTOCOL

Scheduling

- Games will be scheduled every hour and a half for Upward basketball and cheerleading.
- Game play will be 50 minutes.
- There will be a 30-minute dead period to clean benches and seating in between each game to ensure proper disinfecting and cleaning.
- Players, cheerleaders & spectators of the next session of games should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their game start time.
- If you arrive early please remain outside with masks on and follow social distancing guidelines until you are allowed to enter the facility. Please enter in the designated entrance.

Post-Game

- Teams and spectators will be required to IMMEDIATELY leave the gym following their game.
- Elimination of post-game handshakes.

STAFF/VOLUNTEER PROTOCOL

- Staff/volunteers members will complete COVID-19 Questionnaire prior to entering the facility.
- Staff/volunteers members will be required to have their temperature taken each day at the facility prior to entering. Temperature will be taken with a non-contact infrared forehead thermometer. Any staff member with a temperature over 99.9 degrees will be asked to leave.
- Staff/volunteer members are REQUIRED wear a mask during the event.
- Staff/volunteers members will follow social distancing guidelines.

Please note all of these guidelines are subject to change as we continue to monitor the information that becomes available. Be sure to review all CDC guidelines and be prepared to follow them at the event. You can find all information here provided by CDC: <https://www.cdc.gov>.

Questionnaire

All visitors to the facilities at Lebanon Baptist Church must answer the following questions in this COVID-19 screening tool. All responses should be “yes” or “no”:

1. Have you experienced any of the following symptoms in the past 48 hours: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea?
2. Within the past 14 days, have you been in close physical contact (6 feet or closer for at least 15 minutes) with a person who is known to have laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 or with anyone who has any symptoms consistent with COVID-19?
3. Are you isolating or quarantining because you may have been exposed to a person with COVID-19 or are worried that you may be sick with COVID-19?
4. Are you currently waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test?

If you answer “yes” to any of the above questions, you will be denied entry to this facility.

By signing this form, I, along with the organization I represent as well as those who will step foot onto the campus of Lebanon Baptist representing the organization I am associated with, promise to abide by the following guidelines mentioned above. If I, along with those associated with my organization, do not follow any of the guidelines mentioned above, I understand that I forfeit my right to use the facilities at Lebanon Baptist Church.
